第2問題

Do you know what country is the most popular country to visit in the world? The answer is France. About 90 million tourists visit there every year. Half of these visitors come from the UK, Germany, Belgium and Italy. All these countries are very close to France. France is a popular country to visit because it has a long history, many famous museums and buildings, a culture with a lot of interesting traditions and delicious food and wine. It also has beautiful beaches and skiing for people who enjoy the outdoors.

But do you know what countries French people like to visit? All people who work in France receive 5 weeks' holiday each year so they are able to take long trips overseas. They like to visit other countries in Europe such as Spain, Italy and Portugal. These countries are all famous for their sunny weather. Also, you can easily travel to these countries from France by car, train, bus and even bike. However, countries in Asia such as Thailand, Vietnam and Japan have become more popular recently.

The average French family spends €2,200 (or about ¥350,000) on their summer vacation. This is a lot of money but French people spend a lot of time thinking about this holiday. For many families it is the most important event of the year. The graph on the right shows the prices for a one-week vacation in 5 popular countries French people like to visit - Italy, Japan, Portugal, Spain and Vietnam. Japan is the most expensive and Spain the cheapest. Vietnam is more expensive than Italy but cheaper than Portugal.

When French people travel in France, they like to use the Internet to make their own travel schedule, check prices, *reserve their own hotels and flights and so on. By doing this, they can choose the activities they want to do and reduce costs. However when traveling abroad, especially to a country for the first time, they often join group tours. On group tours many people all travel together, stay in the same hotels and visit the same places. Group tours are *organized by *travel agencies which reserve all the flights, buses, hotels and restaurants for the people joining the tour. These group tours are usually a week or longer and are especially popular with elderly people in France. Also a tour guide will often join a group tour. Tour guides can explain the places

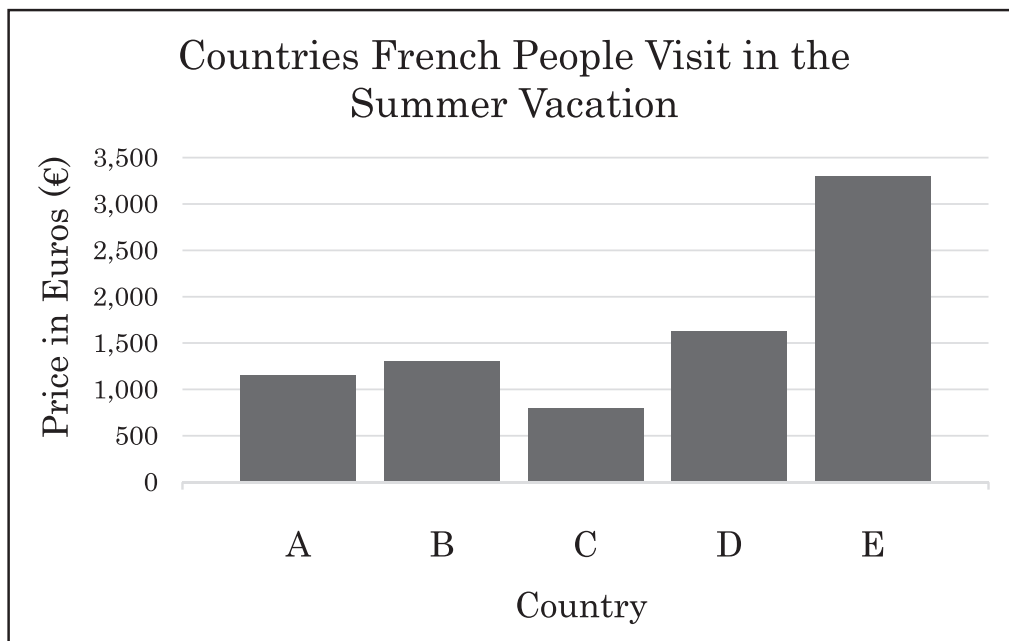
the group is visiting. They are very helpful when they visit countries whose local language is not French.

第3問題

Hiroshima has many famous products. If you are asked what the most famous product from Hiroshima is, how would you answer? You may say lemons, because lemons from Hiroshima are very popular in Japan now. Hiroshima grows 42% of all the lemons produced in Japan. Ehime is second at 31% and Wakayama third at 10%.

The production of lemons in Hiroshima has an interesting history. In 1898, a village in Hiroshima bought many orange trees from Wakayama. However, by mistake there were also three lemon trees among these orange trees. These three lemon trees were grown *as a trial. This is the start of lemon production in Hiroshima. The lemons grew well, because the weather in Hiroshima is good for growing fruit, especially lemons. Hiroshima is very sunny, not very windy and it doesn't rain too much. The lemons are usually grown on islands in *the Seto Inland Sea. The small mountains on these islands protect the lemon trees in bad weather. Also, lemons don't grow well in cold areas and it doesn't often snow in this area.

The price of lemons rose from the end of the Meiji Period (1868-1912) to the beginning of the Taisho Period (1912-1926), and this encouraged lemon production in Hiroshima. The production area increased from 11 *hectares in 1914 to 18 hectares in 1953 and Hiroshima became the biggest producer of lemons in Japan. Between 1953 and 2016 this area increased again to 227 hectares. The amount of lemons grown in Japan has increased a lot over the last 30 years from less than two thousand tons in 1986 to more than ten thousand tons now. Japan also *imports about fifty thousand tons of lemons from abroad. The biggest producers of lemons in the world are India, Mexico and China. However, Japan imports almost all of its lemons from the USA and Chile.

Eighty percent of Hiroshima lemons are sold outside of Hiroshima, usually in the Kanto and Kansai areas. These days, lemons are especially used in many drinks and foods from Hiroshima. Hiroshima is trying hard to make this fruit more popular. Events are often held around Japan that show how to use lemons in cooking and a lot of websites give such information too. Also, many

sweets and souvenirs from Hiroshima have lemon in them. If you visit any souvenir shop in Hiroshima, you will be able to see a lot of products made from lemons. Because of this, Hiroshima lemons are popular in Japan.

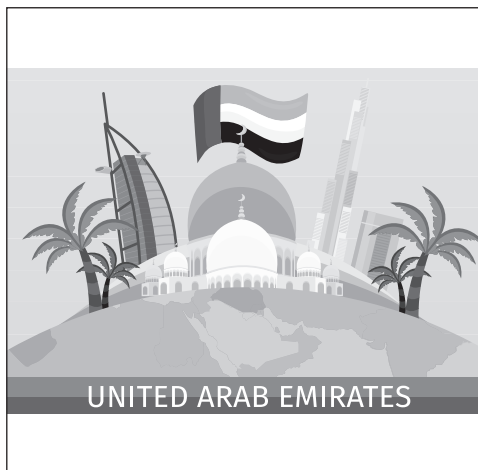
